The National Weather Service will train new and veteran spotters, including interested citizens, amateur radio, CERT, citizen corps, and law enforcement staff, on how to look for and report significant weather events. Training includes video demonstrations. Spotters are needed, particularly in rural parts of King County, as well as those who have weather instrumentation, such as an anemometer.

To Maple Valley:

From I-405:

Take the Maple Valley Highway (exit 4) and drive south. Follow the Maple Valley Hwy. (SR 169) approx. 12 miles. At Witte Road make a right turn. Follow Witte to SE 248th St., turn left onto SE 248th. Follow 248th street past the Greater Maple Valley Community Center. The Lodge sign is straight ahead follow signs to the Lodge parking area. Enter the building through the double doors and go upstairs to the Maple Room.

To Kent RFA:

From I-5 North:

Drive from I-5 S to Des Moines. Take exit 149 from I-5 S
Drive to Military Rd S in Kent
Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto WA-516 E/
Kent Des Moines Rd (signs for Kent)
Turn right onto Military Rd S
Destination will be on the left
