RESOLUTION NO. R-16-1076

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE LOCAL VOTERS' PAMPHLET FOR THE APRIL 26, 2016 ELECTION AND APPOINTING PRO/CON COMMITTEE MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2015, the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Maple Valley, Washington (the "City") adopted Ordinance No. O-15-581 authorizing the submission of a ballot proposition to the voters at the April 26, 2016 election authorizing the City to issue bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$22,500,000 for the purpose of financing the costs of constructing, developing, equipping, upgrading and improving certain park and recreation facilities, including the acquisition of land; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to authorize participation in the local voters pamphlet for the April 26, 2016 election and, pursuant RCW 29A.32.280, to appoint committee members to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval of the measure and committee members to prepare arguments advocating voters' rejection, as set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Voter's Pamphlet. The Council hereby authorizes the City's participation in the local voters' pamphlet for the April 26, 2016 election and requests that King County Elections prepare and publish a voter's pamphlet for the proposition set forth in Ordinance No. O-15-581 adopted by the City Council on October 12, 2015. The pamphlet shall include an explanatory statement and statements in favor of and in opposition to the ballot title. The preparation of the explanatory statement, the appointment of pro/con committees and the preparation of statements in favor of and in opposition to the ballot title shall be in accordance with chapter 29A.32 RCW and the rules and guidelines of King County, as applicable. The City understands and agrees that it will be required to pay its proportionate share of the expenses of the voters' pamphlet and authorizes funds to be used for such purpose.

Section 2. Selection of Committee Members.

(a) The following person(s) are hereby appointed to prepare a statement advocating the voters' approval of the measure:

(b) The following person(s) are hereby appointed to prepare a statement advocating the voters' rejection of the measure:

1. Lawrence Lindstrand

Section 3. Severability. In the event that any provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or invalidate any other provision of this resolution or the bonds as set forth in Ordinance No. O-15-581, but they shall be construed and enforced as if such invalid provision had not been contained herein; provided, however, that any provision which shall for any reason be held by reason of its extent to be invalid shall be deemed to be in effect to the extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
