**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON,
REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR FENCE REPLACEMENT
PROJECT IN STORMWATER PONDS LOCATED IN MAPLE RIDGE
HIGHLAND NEIGHBORHOOD**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Maple Valley desires to replace fencing around three (3) stormwater ponds; and

WHEREAS, the City electronically solicited Invitations to Bid from five (5) contractors identified on the Municipal Research and Services Center (MRSC) Small Work Roster under Fencing and Gates Category; and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2016, the City received only one proposal; and

WHEREAS, in reviewing the bid proposal, the City staff compared the engineering cost estimate and bid proposal and determined that the bid was too high;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bid Rejection: The Maple Valley City Council hereby rejects the bid submitted in response to the Invitations to electronically Bid for the fence replacement project in stormwater ponds located in the Maple Ridge Highland Neighborhood and directs staff to re-bid the Fence Replacement in early 2017.
