**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT MOBILITY ENTERPRISE
(TIME), A MULTIJURISDICTIONAL TRANSPORTATION
BENEFIT DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley residents rely on State Routes 169 and 516 as major commute routes in and out of the City; and

WHEREAS, major capacity and safety improvements are needed outside the City limits along State Routes 169 and 516; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) has no dedicated funding for State Routes 169 and 516; and

WHEREAS, residents of Covington, Black Diamond, Enumclaw and parts of unincorporated King County rely on State Routes for their major commute routes as well; and

WHEREAS, State Law allows for the formation of a regional transportation benefit district to collect license tab fees to fund transportation improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, Maple Valley supports exploring the concept of forming a coalition between multiple jurisdictions with the intent of asking the voters to consider a regional transportation benefit district to provide a local funding match that would be used to leverage funding from the State for capacity and safety improvements along State Routes 169, 516, 410 and 164;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Declaration of Support. The City Council of the City of Maple Valley supports forming a coalition between Maple Valley, Covington, Black Diamond, Enumclaw and areas of unincorporated southeast King County for the purpose of evaluating a regional transportation benefit district for the purposes of providing a local funding match for capacity and safety improvements along State Routes 169, 516, 410 and 164.
