RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1129

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONALS SERVICES C-16-1263 BETWEEN THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY AND OLYMPIC ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES, INC., FOR PROVISION OF MANAGEMENT OF THE 2017-2018 GRANT FUNDED RECYCLING COLLECTION EVENTS.

WHEREAS, Maple Valley City Council adopted Resolution R-16-1074 in February 2016 authorizing a Professional Services Agreement C-16-1263 with Olympic Environmental Resources for provision of managing the City's special recycling collection events; and

WHEREAS, staff applied for and has been awarded grants from King County to implement the Waste Resuction and Recyclilng (WRR) program, and from King County Public Health to implement the Local Hazardous Waste Management program for years 2017 and 2018; and

WHEREAS, Olympic Environmental Resources has extensive experience managing grant funded recycling collection programs for cities throughout King County, including the City of Maple Valley, and continues to be the most qualified firm on the Municipal Research Service Center Consultant Roster; and

WHEREAS, by authorizing Amendment No. 1 to the Olympic Environmental Resources Professional Services Agreement C-16-1263, the City will continue to host the 2017-2018 special recycling collection events with no diret out-of-pocket cost to the city;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with Olympic Environmental Resources Inc., for event management of the 2017 and 2018 grant funded recycling collection events. A copy of the Professional Services Agreement Amendment No. 1 has been filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving No. _____.
