RESOLUTION NO. R -17 1145

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE LICENSING SUPPORT AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL SERVICES WITH KING COUNTY FOR LICENSING AND SUPPORT SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Regional Animal Services of King County (RASKC) provides animal services for unincorporated King County and 25 contract cities supported directly by program revenues as well as general funds from King County and contracting cities; and

WHEREAS, in 2015, the City of Maple Valley's current interlocal agreement with King County for animal services was extended in 2015 to provide animal services through 2017; and

WHEREAS, licensing and support services are required to be considered annually during the contract term and include direct and saturation mailings, door-to-door canvassing, and implementation of jurisdictional marketing campaigns, and

WHEREAS, in return for licensing support from RASKC, the City would provide representation at public events to promote pet licensing and the Animal Services Program, and staff to support pet licensing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley desires to amend the ILA with King County to allow for the provision of licensing and support services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City, Licensing Support Amendment, to Interlocal Agreement with King County for Animal Services to include Licensing and Support Services through the end of 2017.
