**RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1149**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON,  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DONATE 200 SURPLUS  
BANQUET CHAIRS FROM LAKE WILDERNESS LODGE TO THE  
GREATER MAPLE VALLEY COMMUNITY CENTER.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Maple Valley approved the replacement of furniture at the Lake Wilderness Lodge in it's 2017 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department is moving forward with replacing furniture and has deemed certain furniture surplus, including 300 banquet chairs valued at approximately ten to twenty dollars per chair; and

WHEREAS, the Maple Valley Municipal Code Chapter 3.30 entitled "Sale and Disposal of Surplus City-Owned Personal Property" does not specifically authorize the City Manager to donate surplus property valued between \$500-\$10,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to donate 200 of the surplus banquet chairs valued at approximately \$2,000-\$4,000 to the Greater Maple Valley Community Center, a charitable organization that serves the poor and infirm and is tax exempt pursuant to Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) ; and

WHEREAS, all other surplus furniture from Lake Wilderness Lodge will be disposed of pursuant to Chapter 3.30.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to donate 200 surplus banquet chairs from Lake Wilderness Lodge valued at approximately \$2,000.00-\$4,000.00 to the Greater Maple Valley Community Center, a charitable organization serving the poor and infirm...
