

**CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON
ORDINANCE NO. O-17-616**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY,
WASHINGTON, RELATING TO ESTABLISHING
REGULATIONS RELATED TO LOW IMPACT DEVELOPMENT
(LID) PRINCIPLES AND BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES
(BMPS) APPLICABLE FOR TITLE 12 AND TITLE 13**

WHEREAS, under current National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Stormwater Permit, the City of Maple Valley is required to revise the development codes and standards to make stormwater low impact development (LID) the preferred and commonly-used approach to site developments; and

WHEREAS, the effective date of the implementation of the interim regulations will expire on May 29, 2017; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. The “Whereas” clauses above shall constitute findings of fact in support of the need to adopt the interim municipal code amendments hereafter set forth and incorporated herein.

Section 2: Titles 12 and 13 of the Maple Valley Municipal Code entitled “Streets, Sidewalks and Public Spaces” and “Storm Drainage and Surface Water Management Utility” respectively, are hereby amended to read as set forth in attachments A and B respectively, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full. Revisions are shown as standard underline and ~~strike through~~.

Section 3: Effective Period. This ordinance amending the City’s municipal code shall be effective five days after publication of a summary thereof, consisting of the title.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance should be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance.
