**RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1151**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON,  
APPROVING A FINAL PLAT AND ACCEPTING A 51-LOT SUBDIVISION  
KNOWN AS CANTON CROSSING**

**WHEREAS**, on June 12, 2015, application was made to the City of Maple Valley for the preliminary approval of a subdivision known as Shavano Park (CD1506-007); and

**WHEREAS**, on February 9, 2016, the City of Maple Valley Hearing Examiner preliminarily approved Shavano Park subject to conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 8, 2017, the developer of Canton Crossing (formerly Shavano Park) applied for a final plat review of Canton Crossing (CD1702-001); and

**WHEREAS**, City of Maple Valley staff has determined that each condition of approval as established by the Order of the Hearing Examiner and that each condition of approval established by the Director's decision in connection with the minor revision has been met or appropriate provisions have been made;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Approval. Pursuant to RCW 58.17.170, the City Council of the City of Maple Valley finds that the conditions of preliminary plat approval for Canton Crossing have been met, and hereby approves the final plat.

Section 2. Authorization. The Mayor, Public Works and Community Development Director and Finance Director or authorized designees are hereby authorized by the City Council to sign the face of the plat of Canton Crossing to allow the applicant to record the plat document with King County.
