RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1141

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY AND TYLER TECHNOLOGIES FOR DATA CONVERSION FROM VISION MS SOFTWARE TO TYLER TECHNOLOGIES INCODE SOFTWARE.

WHEREAS, the City, in 2015, implemented a conversion of the financial software from Vision MS Financial Software to Tyler Technologies InCode; and

WHEREAS, during the implementation of new Finance software in 2015, only 2 previous years and the current year data were migrated; thus leaving 2 years of data (2011 and 2012) on the old Vision MS Financial Software Server; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to complete the 2011 and 2012 data conversion to meet standards set by DRS (Department of Retirement Services) requirements and records retention law to keep all records for employment for 60 years in their original format and/or meet data migration standards; and

WHEREAS, the implementation would eliminate the need for annual maintenance costs of \$9,233 (\$6,300 per year for the Vision MS Software and an associated cost of \$2,933 per year for SQL Server software) and the data would then fall under the existing Tyler Technologies InCode maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract in an amount not to exceed \$38,000 with Tyler Technologies to implement the conversion of data for 2011 and 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City, the Tyler Technologies contract in an amount not to exceed \$38,000, for the provision of the data conversion from Vision MS Software to Tyler Technologies InCode software. A copy of the contract shall be filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving No. _____.
