RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1154

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH PBS FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN OF THE REALIGNMENT OF SE 256TH STREET AND WITTE ROAD INTERSECTION AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE I OF PROJECT NO. T-28b.

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley was awarded a King County Flood Control District grant, in the amount of \$295,000, to enhance the existing culvert at SE 256th Street in order to improve fish habitat; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley has determined that the improvements at the SE 256th Street and Witte Road intersection are necessary and justified; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley desires to construct these proposed infrastructure improvements at the earliest date practical; and

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated a scope of services and associated fee with PBS for the design of transportation and drainage improvements at the intersection of SE 256th Street and Witte Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement for Professional Services with PBS to provide engineering services for the Design of SE 256th Street and Witte Road Intersection Improvements in an amount not to exceed \$51,476. A copy of the Agreement has been filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving No. _____.
