## RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1169

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, TO AWARD THE BID FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES ON T-24 MAPLE VALLEY CROSSWALK AND RRFB IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO WELWEST CONSTRUCTION INC. AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH WELWEST CONSTRUCTION INC.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Maple Valley desires to construct the improvements for T-24, Maple Valley Crosswalk and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited Invitations to Bid from individual construction firms qualified to complete Project T – 24, Maple Valley Crosswalk and RRFB Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the City received 1 proposal in response to the City's Invitation to Bid; and

WHEREAS, Welwest Construction Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed bid documents submitted by Welwest Construction Inc. and has found them to be substantially complete; and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting that the City Manager be granted the authorization to execute a Public Works Contract with Welwst Construction Inc. to perform the construction services for T-24 Maple Valley Crosswalk and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) Improvements Project in the total bid amount of \$159,000;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Bid award. The City Council hereby awards the bid to complete , Maple Valley Crosswalk and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) Improvements Project (T-24) to Welwest Consturction Inc., the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

Section 2. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Public Works Contract with Welwest Construction Inc., to perform the Construction Services for Maple Valley Crosswalk and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) Improvements Project (T-24) in the total bid amount of \$159,000 to by Welwest Construction Inc. This contract includes a 10% owner's contingency. A copy of the Public Works Contract has been filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_.
