RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1171

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A “LOCAL PROGRAMS STATE FUNDING AGREEMENT” FOR AWARD OF “SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL” PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS BETWEEN THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY AND THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT).

WHEREAS, the City Public Works department is in the process of completing the design of the 243RD Place SE Shared Use Path (Student Walkway) (T-41) Capital improvement project; and

WHEREAS, the project will construct a 10’ wide ADA accessible paved pedestrian shared use path within the existing 243rd Place SE ROW between SE 260th Street and SE 261st Street.

WHEREAS, in June 21, 2017 WSDOT awarded the City of Maple Valley a grant in the amount of \$164,430.0

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a “Local Programs State Funding Agreement” for award of Safe Routes to School grant funds between the City of Maple Valley and the Washington State Department of Transportation.
