ORDINANCE NO. O-17-624

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, RECLASSIFYING ONE CURRENT POSITION TO A NEW CLASSIFICATION WITH CORRESPONDING SALARY SCALE WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16-596, BY AMENDING THE 2017-2018 SALARY SCHEDULE TO ADD THIS NEW CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY RANGE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR CORRECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Maple Valley City Council adopted Ordinance No. 16-596, the 2017-2018 Biennial Budget (“Biennial Budget”), effective January 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Appendix “J” of the Biennial Budget entitled “Salary Schedule” sets forth job classifications along with their associated salary range; and

WHEREAS, City staff have determined it appropriate to reclassify one of the Public Works Maintenance II positions within the Public Works Department to a Public Works Maintenance I position; and

WHEREAS, a salary range of \$43,005 - \$56,511, commensurate with this new classification entitled Public Works Maintenance Worker I, shall be set forth within the Salary Schedule; and

WHEREAS, the current classification entitled Public Works Maintenance Worker II with commensurate salary range shall remain within the 2017-2018 Salary Schedule; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment to the 2017-2018 Biennial Budget. Appendix “J” of the Biennial Budget entitled “Salary Schedule” as adopted by Ordinance 16-596, shall be amended as follows:

New classification entitled “Public Works Maintenance Worker I” with a salary range of \$43,005 - \$56,511 is added to the Salary Schedule. One current Public Works classification entitled “Maintenance Worker II” with associated salary range shall be removed from the Salary Schedule, therefore the current Public Works Maintenance Worker II FTEs within the Public Works Department shall be reduced from 3 FTEs to 2 FTEs within the Salary Schedule.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. Effective date. A summary of this ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.

Section 4. Corrections by City Clerk or Code Reviser. Upon approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the code reviser are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance, including the correction of clerical errors; references to other local, state or federal laws, codes, rules or regulations; or ordinance numbering and section/subsection numbering.
