**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PUBLIC WORKS EMERGENCY RESPONSE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PARTICIPATING SIGNATORY AGENCIES TO PROVIDE A MECHANISM FOR AGENCIES TO ASSIST ONE ANOTHER DURING EMERGENCIES OR DISASTERS**

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that Public Works has the responsibility to maintain services and recover expeditiously from disasters and emergencies, and;

WHEREAS, coordinating response and recovery efforts with other public works agencies can enhance the City's ability to better protect the public and property, and

WHEREAS, by having the Mutual Aid Agreement in place allows the City to obtain the maximum reimbursement possible from appropriate state and federal agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Authorization. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute a Mutual Aid Agreement with Washington State Department of Transportation and participating signatory agencies to receive or provide mutual aid during proclaimed disasters or emergencies. A copy of the agreement will be filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving No. 1363.
