RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1206

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION(S) FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR A WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM (WWRP) PROJECT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SUMMIT PARK AND BALLFIELDS PROJECT TO THE RECREATION AND CONSERVATION OFFICE (RCO) AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 79A.15 RCW, ACQUISITION OF HABITAT CONSERVATION AND OUTDOOR RECREATION LANDS

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley City Council has approved a comprehensive plan that includes this project area; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of WWRP, state funding assistance is requested to aid in financing the cost of facility development; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Maple Valley considers it in the best public interest to complete the facility development project described in the application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Authorization: The City Manager is hereby authorized to make formal application to the Recreation and Conservation Office for funding assistance, and to make the acknowledgements and certifications listed herein:

1. Any funding assistance received must be used for implementation of the project referenced above;
2. The City of Maple Valley hereby certifies that its share of project funding is committed and will be derived from appropriations and/or cash;
3. The City of Maple Valley, through its City Manager, acknowledges that the City is responsible for supporting all non-cash commitments to this project should they not materialize;
4. The City is aware that the grant, if approved, will be paid on a reimbursement basis. This means the City may only request payment after eligible and allowable costs have already been paid and remitted to its vendors.
5. The City Manager acknowledges that any property acquired or facility developed with financial aid from the Recreation and Conservation

Funding Board (RCFB) must be placed in use for the funded purpose and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the City and RCFB.

6. This resolution becomes part of a formal application to the Recreation and Conservation Office; and

7. The City Council provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.
