

**CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON**

**RESOLUTION NO. R-17-1189**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, REAUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE “AGREEMENT FOR INMATE HOUSING 2018” BETWEEN THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY AND YAKIMA COUNTY FOR THE PROVISION OF JAIL SERVICES.**

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34.030 authorizes an agreement for joint or cooperative action by a public agency upon appropriate legislative action by the governing body of each agency prior to entry into such agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, Maple Valley is responsible for the incarceration of defendants held pending resolution of misdemeanor cases and upon conviction for misdemeanor crimes committed in Maple Valley (“Maple Valley Inmates”); and

WHEREAS, Maple Valley does not own a facility suitable for incarcerating Maple Valley Inmates; and

WHEREAS, Yakima County operates a corrections facility known as the Yakima County Corrections Facility; and

WHEREAS, Yakima County provides the City of Maple Valley with jail services pursuant to an agreement which is set to expire December 31, 2017;

WHEREAS, Yakima County is willing to continue to provide for the housing of Maple Valley Inmates pursuant to “Agreement for Inmate Housing 2018;”

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2017, the City Council, pursuant to the consent agenda, authorized the City Manager to execute Addendum No. 2 with Yakima County; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 17-1182 had some inaccurate references which this Resolution seeks to clarify; and

WHEREAS, the “Agreement for Inmate Housing 2018” includes an approximately 4% daily rate increase per inmate which will result in a daily rate of \$53.85 through \$59.85 depending on the monthly average daily population; and

WHEREAS, the rate increase of approximately 4% was primarily due to an increase in Yakima County’s overall services; and

WHEREAS, the “Agreement for Inmate Housing 2018” provides for a continuous term expiring December 31, 2022, as opposed to an annual term, except when there is a rate increase and/or language change to the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Maple Valley seeks to enter into the “Agreement for Inmate Housing 2018” with Yakima County for the provision of jail services;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Re-authorization of City Manager. The City Manager is hereby re-authorized to execute the “Agreement for Inmate Housing 2018” between the City of Maple Valley and Yakima County relating to the provision of jail services as attached hereto. A copy of the “Agreement for Inmate housing 2018” has been filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk’s Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.
