RESOLUTION NO. R-18-1218

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE PARKS & RECREATION DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A “KING COUNTY YOUTH & AMATEUR SPORTS GRANT AGREEMENT” FOR AWARD OF GRANT FUNDS BETWEEN THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY AND KING COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the City Parks and Recreation Department replaced the playground at Lake Wilderness Park to rave reviews from the community while also adding an inclusive play element; and

WHEREAS, the City and King County have a lasting partnership in providing parks and recreation facilities for community enjoyment, health and wellness, and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, King County awarded the City of Maple Valley a grant in the amount of \$5,000 to assist in funding the Lake Wilderness Playground project;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The Parks and Recreation Director is hereby authorized to execute a “Youth & Amateur Sports Grant Agreement” for award of King County Get Active/Stay Active program funds between the City of Maple Valley and King County.
