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Project: T28b SE 256th Street Realignment

Construction Start Date: July 9, 2018

Construction End Date: September 1- September 30 (estimated)

The City will begin realignment of SE 256th Street between Witte Road and 220th Ave SE on July 9th, 2018. This project will include relocating power and telephone utilities underground along Witte Rd, installing a large fish passage culvert in Jenkins Creek, and realigning SE 256th Street to a near 90th approach to Witte Road improving turning sight distance.

Expected Traffic Delays:

- Underground utility installation (week 1): Southbound Witte Road traffic will be detoured onto 220th Avenue SE and SE 256th Street then back onto Witte Rd to minimize flagging delays.
- Underground utility installation (week 2): As this work proceeds south of SE 256th Street, two way flagging on Witte Road will be necessary for both directions for this portion of the work.
- Culvert installation and Street Realignment: SE 256th Street will be closed for the majority of the project to allow free flow traffic on 220 Avenue SE and Witte Road as much as possible.
