RESOLUTION NO. R-18-1239

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE “KING COUNTY WATER WORKS PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT” WITH KING COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the City Public Works department has a need to retrofit seven stormwater ponds in the City to improve water quality treatment in the areas served by those ponds; and

WHEREAS, the City and King County have has a lasting partnership in improving water quality through proactive stormwater treatment efforts; and

WHEREAS, in February 15, 2018, King County awarded the City of Maple Valley a grant in the amount of \$20,000 to assist in funding the improvement and retrofit these stormwater ponds;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the “2017 Water Works Council Grant Program Agreement” with King County. Clerks Receiving No. 2772, Contract No. C-18-1490
