RESOLUTION NO. R-18-1266

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH KING COUNTY TO ESTABLISH PAYMENT, CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF SUMMIT PARK & BALLFIELDS BID ALTERNATE NO. 1.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to construct a park facility known as the Summit Park & Ballfields; and

WHEREAS, the City bid documents included a number of bid alternates, including Alternate No. 1, which provided for the construction of a trailhead parking area at the King County Cedar-to-Green Rivers trailhead; and

WHEREAS, the City opened bids on June 20, 2018, and because all of the bids exceeded the Project's estimate, the City Council awarded the base bid only, without any alternates, to Terra Dynamics on July 9, 2018; and

WHEREAS, King County has reviewed the Project contract documents and the Alternate No. 1 specifications and has determined that it would be in King County's interest to pay the City sufficient funds to construct bid Alternate No. 1 as part of the Project; and

WHEREAS, King County and the City would like to enter into an agreement that establishes payment, construction and maintenance of Summit Park & Ballfields Bid Alternate No. 1;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Authorization: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interagency Agreement with King County to establish payment, construction and maintenance of Summit Park & Ballfields bid Alternate No. 1 (trailhead parking). The City Manager is authorized to make revisions to the Agreement as requested by the County, with City Attorney approval, as long as such revisions effectuate the purposes for which the Agreement is sought. The Agreement shall be filed with the City Clerk and identified with the Clerk's Receiving Number 2789.
