

CAMP WILD FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions

- **What are the hours of camp?**
 - Camp hours are 9:00am-4:00pm, Monday-Friday. Please be as close to those times as possible. Before-care hours are 7:30am-9:00am and After-care hours are 4:00pm-5:30pm, for additional charge.
- **How much is Before/After Care?**
 - Before **and** After-care for the week is \$60. Day of After or Before Care will be \$30 (pre-arranged and pre-paid). These prices are all per child. (Week 2 fees are adjusted to \$48)
- **Is there a wait list?**
 - Yes. There are 46 camp spaces available each week and as soon as camp is full you will be placed on the wait list. The wait list has 12 spots available. If a space becomes available the first person on the list will be called. If you don't answer your phone, staff will leave a message with the necessary information to register your camper. You may call to see where you are on the list. If you have more than one child you want to attend camp, be sure to register early.
- **How are groups made?**
 - We split our campers into five groups with one leader. We determine groups by age but are able to take requests if siblings or friends close in age need to be split or would like to be together. This can be done by contacting the Day Camp Manager and needs to be done before the first day of the assigned week. Leaders also rotate groups each week. So returning campers will get a new leader each week they come back. All groups are co-ed.
- **Is lunch provided?**
 - Lunch is **not** provided. Please send your child with a sack lunch and water bottle each day.
- **What should my child bring to camp each day?**
 - Bathing suit, towel, and plastic bag for wet clothes, water bottle, sunscreen, snack, lunch and athletic/closed-toe-shoes. Please make sure that all items sent to camp are clearly labeled with your child's name.
- **What should my child refrain from bringing to camp?**
 - Anything valuable! Trading cards, iPods, portable game systems, money, or anything else of value should be left at home in order to ensure the safety of your child's belongings, as well as their safety and participation in group activities.
- **Does the camp have a camper discipline plan?**
 - We utilize a green card system. Each camper will start on a green every day.
 - **Green Card** - Go! You are free to participate and have fun with the group.
 - **Yellow Card** - Slow Down... 5 minute cool down from the activity
 - **Red Card** - Stop! 5 minute sit out from activity and removal from next free time. Campers will spend either lunch or snack time inside and will participate in filling out a behavioral FYI to be sent home with parent.

- **If my child doesn't want to swim, is there another option?**
 - Yes. Whether it is normal swimming time at the lake or a field trip we offer alternative options such as archery, playground and other games. Please notify a staff member if your child will not be swimming.

- **What if I am late to pick up my Child?**
 - There is a late pick up policy where you will be charged \$5.00 per child after a grace period (first 5 minutes) with an additional fee of \$1.00 per child for every minute after the grace period. An invoice will be given to the late parent/guardian upon arrival or sent via email that evening indicating the fee and stating it must be paid in full before a camper will be permitted to participate in the next day of camp. No payments can be accepted by camp staff. Please pay in the Parks & Recreation office.
