WELCOME AND REVIEW AGENDA

- The meeting was called to order by Chair Brent Pennington at 6:00 pm.

ROLL CALL

- Chair Brent Pennington took roll call and noted Commissioners present as noted above.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

- Minutes of the January 1, 2019 meeting were approved as prepared.

PARKS & RECREATION CAPITAL PROJECTS PRESENTATION

- Parks & Recreation Director Dave Johnson shared a presentation and information regarding Public Art at Summit Park:
 - Map of Summit Park, which has an estimated completion date of June 2019.
 - Recommended Public Art opportunities in the park include:
 - Transformer utility box wrap,
 - Fence Art,
 - Murals for skate park (not building),
 - Sculptures.

PUBLIC WORKS CAPITAL PROJECTS PRESENTATION

- City Engineer Bill Bullock shared a presentation and information regarding Public Art for the retaining wall portion of the SR 169 Widening Phase 1 Roadway Improvements project:
 - Reviewed the finish of the retaining wall selected by Public Art Commissioners in 2018.
 - Explained structure of the retaining wall and how artwork can be attached and location for artwork:
 - Bolts from artwork attached into timber lagging through concrete fascia.
 - Artwork should be attached to retaining wall so bottom edge is no lower than 8 feet from ground.
 - Wall length is approximately 950 feet long with nominal height of 12 to 15 feet and 5 feet at both ends.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT/COMMUNICATIONS

- Economic Development Manager Tim Morgan and Communications Specialist Jennifer Cusmir shared information about the City Rebranding RFP:
 - Rebranding is 6 to 9 month process. Selected vendor will meet with local and City organizations.
 - Brand of City can be communicated and represented via public art.

Preliminary

- As a gateway into and out of Maple Valley, public art for SR 169 retaining wall capital project is a suggested canvas to share the spirit of the city and the 'Maple Valley experience'.

CONTINUED BUSINESS

- **2018 PAC Presentation to Council**
 - The presentation was reviewed with commissioners.
 - Commissioners were asked to support PAC and Chair Brent Pennington by attending the City Council Meeting on March 25th if available.
- **Bear Sculpture Update**
 - The plaque design approved by City Council on March 11th was shared with commissioners.
 - Landscaping in the round-about is expected to be completed in April.
 - Unveiling date TBD.
- **Lake Wilderness lodge Art Exhibition Program**
 - One new artist signed up to exhibit for April-June.
 - Dorothy will send uninstal/install dates to commissioners.
 - Dorothy will send a Doodle Poll with options for a grand opening/artist reception.
- **PAC Street Art**
 - Project will begin in May or June with weather permitting.
 - Commissioners were asked to send project ideas/materials required to Dorothy by April 12, 2019.
- **2019 Work Plan**
 - Commissioners reviewed and agreed upon the 2019 Work Plan.
 - Jennifer Cusmir has agreed to design artwork for a historic utility box.
- **Subcommittees**
 - Subcommittee assignments were discussed.

NEW BUSINESS

- **Artwork for Parks & Recreation Capital Project**
 - Commissioners discussed artwork ideas and agreed upon the following:
 - Transformer utility box wrap.
 - Fence art – depending on mesh attachment and if artwork is still feasible.
- **Artwork for Public Works Capital Project**
 - Commissioners discussed options for Call to Artist and agreed to artist interpretation of the 'spirit of Maple Valley'.
