ORDINANCE NO. O-19-671

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING APPENDIX “M” OF THE 2019-2020 BIENNIAL BUDGET TO ADD ANEW CLASSIFICATION ENTITLED “FACILITIES MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN” WITH A COMMENSURATE SALARY RANGE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR CORRECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Maple Valley City Council adopted Ordinance No. **18-655**, the 2019-2020 Biennial Budget (“Biennial Budget”), effective January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Appendix “M” of the Biennial Budget entitled “Salary Schedule” sets forth job classifications along with their associated salary range; and

WHEREAS, City staff have determined it appropriate to create a new classification entitled “Facilities Maintenance Technician” position within the Parks & Recreation Department and to reclassify the incumbent Custodian to this new classification effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, a salary range of \$58,547 - \$74,080, commensurate with this new classification entitled Facilities Maintenance Technician, shall be set forth within the Salary Schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to amend Appendix “M” of the 2019-2020 Biennial Budget to add a new classification entitled “Facilities Maintenance Technician” with a commensurate salary range;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment to the 2019-2020 Biennial Budget. Appendix “M” of the Biennial Budget entitled “Salary Schedule” as adopted by Ordinance **18-655**, shall be amended as follows:

New classification entitled “Facilities Maintenance Technician” with a salary range of \$58,547 - \$74,080 is added to the Salary Schedule.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not

affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. Effective date. A summary of this ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.

Section 4. Corrections by City Clerk or Code Reviser. Upon approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the code reviser are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance, including the correction of clerical errors; references to other local, state or federal laws, codes, rules or regulations; or ordinance numbering and section/subsection numbering.
