RESOLUTION NO. R-19-1400

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TAHOMA SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR JOINT USE OF FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City and Tahoma School District desire to provide well operated and maintained facilities for public use by the community, in order to promote efficient facility use and increase recreational opportunities for the community, and:

WHEREAS, chapter 39.34 RCW (Interlocal Cooperation Act) permits local government to make the most efficient use of their power by enabling them to cooperate with other government entities on the basis of mutual advantage, and:

WHEREAS, the City and the District entered into an interlocal agreement governing joint use of City and District facilities in August 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City and District have met over the past several months to review the terms of the interlocal agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and District have agreed to revisions to the interlocal agreement that establish the prioritization of use, scheduling and maintenance of certain City and District owned facilities by the City, District and Community Based User Groups; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to authorize the City Manager to execute the revised interlocal agreement with the District for joint use of facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the Tahoma School District for the joint use of facilities.
