



Witte Road improvement Project (T-28b Ph 2) SE 249th Place to SE 256th Street

Project Update

Construction is planned to start in May 2020. The project will improve safety on Witte Road SE from SE 249th Place to SE 256th Street by adding sidewalks, bike lanes, lighting, and dedicated left turn and acceleration lanes for the SE 254th Place and SE 256th Street intersections with Witte Road. The project will include major water quality improvements, including daylighting a piped section of Jenkins Creek and adding a fish passage culvert across Witte Road. Overhead power and dry utilities will also be undergrounded.

Traffic Management


Due to the added efficiencies of detouring traffic and allowing a contractor to work on a fully closed road, the City has determined traffic through the construction zone will be managed by detours. The attached map shows the detours that are planned during construction including:

- Commuter Detour - SR 169/Kent Kangley Road
- Local Traffic Detour - Lake Wilderness Country Club Drive
- Neighborhood Detour - Cedar Downs roads


Full road closure of Witte Road will only be allowed from June 18 to August 30, 2020 from Monday morning to Thursday evening. Witte will be opened to traffic Friday morning through Sunday night. All other days, traffic will be managed with flaggers for one lane of travel through Witte Road.

To mitigate increased traffic volumes through Lake Wilderness Country Club Drive, the City will provide the following:

- Monday through Friday detour only from June 18 to August 30
- Detour of commuter traffic from Kent Kangley and Maple Valley Highway so that they will not use Lake Wilderness Country Club Drive
- Local traffic only will be allowed through Lake Wilderness Country Club Drive
- LED speed limit signage throughout Lake Wilderness Country Club Drive
- Temporary speed humps and signage for three golf cart crossings
- Police presence throughout with “Fines Doubling in Construction Zone” and signs indicated “Speeds Strictly Enforced”
