RESOLUTION NO. R-20-1446

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH KBA, INC. TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR PROJECT T-39: SR 169 WIDENING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City has a need to make critical transportation improvements on the SR 169 corridor between Witte Road SE and SE 240th Street; and

WHEREAS, these improvements will reduce congestion and collision risk by the addition of a north bound travel lane, improved transit access, new pedestrian sidewalk and bicycles lanes, and access management features; and

WHEREAS, the City has selected KBA Inc. as the preferred candidate in a selection process among five consultants, using the MRSC roster, to provide construction management services for the SR 169 Widening Project; and

WHEREAS, City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a professional services agreement (C-19-1560) with KBA, Inc. on March 9, 2019 for construction management services for the T-39 SR 169 Widening project; and

WHEREAS, Professional Service Contract C-19-1560 included assumptions that require amendments to the budget for KBA to continue services to the City to complete the construction management of the T-39 SR 169 Widening Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Professional Services Contract Amendment No. 3 with KBA, Inc., to provide additional construction management services for the T-39 project totaling \$30,600 for a new total not to exceed amount of \$722,661. A copy of Professional Services Contract C-19-1560 Amendment No. 3 has been filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving No. 3189.
