City of Maple Valley Announces the Opening of the Legacy Site

Maple Valley, Wash. – July 9, 2020 – The City of Maple Valley is excited to announce the activation of the 54-acre Legacy Site with the opening of the 2020 Maple Valley Farmers’ Market at 9:00am on Saturday, July 11. The Maple Valley Farmers' Market is one of the Top 10 farmers’ markets in Washington State. The market will operate every Saturday from 9:00am to 2:00pm from July 11th through September 26th.

The Maple Valley Farmers’ Market is located along the eastern property boundary along State Route 169 across from Rock Creek Elementary School. The Market will occupy five acres of the site with one acre dedicated to the Market and four acres dedicated to associated parking. The Market is a vibrant community gathering place not only for the residents of Maple Valley but for people living in the surrounding area as well.

Due to the COVID-19 and safety considerations, the Market’s primary objective this season will be the distribution of fresh food and essential products only. The Market will operate with a modified layout with enforced social distancing, sanitation, and safety measures in place. Vendor categories such as artists, artisans, craftspeople, community groups, non-profits, and young entrepreneurs will not be exhibiting this year due to the restrictions. In addition, there will be no on-site entertainment, food production, or dining available this year.

Mark Hoben, President of the Maple Valley Farmers’ Market states, “We are excited to share this beautiful, uniquely Maple Valley facility with our vendors and the community. I want to thank the Mayor, our City Council, and the City of Maple Valley staff for their strong support of the Market through the development of this site.”
