**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SUBLEASE
AGREEMENT WITH KING COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, the King County Sheriff's Office (KCSO) intends to move out of its current location in southeast King County known as "Precinct 3" in Maple Valley and centralize locations and consolidate operations for Precinct 2 and Precinct 3 in the City of Sammamish no later than October 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, KCSO has asked the City of Maple Valley (City) to provide office space for nine deputies and one patrol sergeant within premises leased by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City welcomes the presence of additional KCSO Officers within the City, as backup, when possible, for City Officers; and

WHEREAS, the City and King County have agreed that KCSO will sublease space from the City under the terms and conditions of a Sublease Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Execution of Sublease Agreement Authorized. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Sublease Agreement with King County for nine patrol deputies and one patrol sergeant, for use as administrative office space.
