**RESOLUTION NO. R-12-846**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH TAHOMA SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CURRICULUM TO EDUCATE STUDENTS AND FAMILIES ABOUT STORM WATER POLLUTION SOLUTIONS.**

WHEREAS, Washington State Department of Ecology provided the city a Municipal Storm Water Capacity Grant to aid the city in implementing the requirements of the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit; and

WHEREAS, both the Storm Water Capacity Grant and the NPDES permit provide that the city may rely on another entity to implement some portions of the program; and

WHEREAS, the city desires to enter into an agreement with Tahoma School District #409 for the provision of a multi-grade level Storm Water Thinking curriculum that includes elements of public involvement and outreach intended to increase awareness and reduce or eliminate behaviors and practices that cause or contribute to adverse storm water impacts; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Maple Valley hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the Tahoma School District for the development of a curriculum to educate students and families about stormwater pollution solutions.
