**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH KING COUNTY FOR JAIL
SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley has no jail facilities for prisoners under arrest or who have been incarcerated; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley is a participant in the Jail Administration Group (JAG), an entity whose purpose is to negotiate for bed space with King County at a reasonable price; and

WHEREAS, King County Jail accepts prisoners with drug or alcohol dependencies as well as prisoners with psychiatric illnesses and therefore has the capability of addressing serious medical needs of prisoners; and

WHEREAS, at this time the City of Maple Valley has no other reasonable alternatives within the Puget Sound region for jail services for prisoners with special needs and the jail extension agreement is the result of a negotiation process between King County and the cities that form the Jail Administration Group (JAG);

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley desires to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with King County under new pricing terms for jail services in order to have a jail facility available for special needs prisoners, and to obtain the best possible price for jail services;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Maple Valley the “Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Maple Valley and King County for Jail Services.” A copy of this Agreement has been filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk’s Receiving No. _____.
