RESOLUTION NO. R-12-882

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH 4CULTURE FOR PROVISION OF RECEIVING GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Lake Wilderness Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) established in 2006 with Council adoption of Resolution R-06-495 and subsequent amending Resolutions R-07-518 and R-08-576 is tasked with advising the city on the implementation of the aquatic plant management and public education and stewardship for Lake Wilderness; and

WHEREAS, the CAC 2011-2012 annual work plan included the exploration of funding options for planning and design development for six quality educational signs in Lake Wilderness Park; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the CAC staff applied for and has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$5,000 from 4Culture for the planning and design development of six historical/cultural and environmental signs for the Lake Wilderness Park; and

WHEREAS, the signage project is a two phased project with Phase One consisting of the planning and design development for the signs and Phase Two consisting of the fabrication and installation of the signs; and

WHEREAS, the 4Culture Agreement will fund the Phase One work only and staff will continue to explore funding options for the Phase Two work;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the 4Culture for the provision of receiving grant funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the Phase One planning and design development for signage for the Lake Wilderness Park. A copy of the contract shall be filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving Number
