**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY,
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL
SERVICES WITH KING COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, the City is currently a party to an interlocal agreement with King County for Animal Services, which will terminate on December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue to contract with King County for Animal Services for an additional three years beginning January 1, 2013 (the "Successor Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City Manager participated in several meetings to discuss the provision of animal services throughout the County, and has monitored the development of a Successor Agreement and has recommended that the City Council approve the Successor Agreement as being in the best interests of the City of Maple Valley and its citizens;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with King County for Animal Services to begin January 1, 2013 for a three year term. A copy of this agreement shall be filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving Number _____.
