**RESOLUTION NO. R-12-853**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PURSUE ALL AVAILABLE LEGAL REMEDIES AGAINST MICHAEL P. CROSSON FOR VIOLATION OF MAPLE VALLEY MUNICIPAL CODE 12.10.560**

WHEREAS, the City issued a Notice of Violation and Order to Michael P. Crosson on January 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, no response to the Notice of Violation and Order was received from Mr. Crosson; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Crosson failed to appeal the Notice of Violation and Order by the 14-day appeal period; and

WHEREAS, by failing to appeal the Notice of Violation and Order, the civil code violation is deemed to have been committed; and

WHEREAS, in order to enforce the administrative decision, the City of Maple Valley must request the Superior Court to issue an order directing abatement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to authorize the City Attorney to pursue all available legal remedies against Mr. Crosson for the violation of the City of Maple Valley Municipal Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to file suit against Michael P. Crosson and to pursue any other legal remedies deemed necessary or expedient to remedy the violation of the Maple Valley Municipal Code pursuant to the Notice of Violation and Order issued by the City on January 31, 2012.
