RESOLUTION NO. R-12-889

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON,
REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE
LAKE LUCERNE OUTFALL RESTORATION PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Maple Valley desires to to construct the Lake Lucerne Outfall Resoration Project; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited Invitations to Bid from individual construction firms qualified to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2012 the City received four bid proposals that ranged in cost from \$109,794.60 to \$184,495.65; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bid of \$109,794.60 was approximately \$26,071 (31%) more than the engineer's cost estimate of \$83,724;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Council hereby rejects all bids received and directs the staff to re-bid the project in 2013.
