RESOLUTION R-12-900

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON ADOPTING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT TO TERMINATE THE GREATER MAPLE VALLEY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AREA INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Valley adopted the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) in 2012; and

WHEREAS, the CEMP entirely replaces an earlier interlocal agreement known as the “Greater Maple Valley Emergency Management Area Interlocal Agreement” (GMVEMA ILA) in 1999; and

WHEREAS, the GMVEMA ILA is effectively obsolete as the City is mandated to and is now operating under the CEMP in compliance with Chapter 38.52 RCW;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Maple Valley hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the “Interlocal Agreement Between The City of Maple Valley And King County Terminating Greater Maple Valley Emergency Management Area Interlocal Agreement.”
