

City of Maple Valley CALL FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Maple Valley, Washington, at the reception desk located at 22017 SE Wax Road, Suite 200, Maple Valley Washington until 2:00 p.m., June 13, 2013. Bids will then be opened and publicly read at 2:02 p.m. on that same day at City Hall, 22017 SE Wax Road, Suite 200, Maple Valley, WA 98038, for:

SR 169 and SE 271st Place Intersection Improvements

Note: The Proposed Subcontractors list must be submitted with the bid package within the deadline listed above, and will NOT be accepted after that deadline.

The Work to be performed within **90** working days from the date of Notice to Proceed consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and other work or items incidental thereto for:

The project consists of designing and constructing a new 3-way traffic signal at the intersection of SR 169 and SE 271st Place, including the installation of signal poles, controller, and connections to WSDOT's SR 169 traffic signal interconnect system. The project will also construct approximately 230 LF of concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk along the west side of SR 169, which completes the sidewalk system. The project will provide re-channelization improvements at the intersection to improve LOS and support the new traffic signal. Additional improvements include curbing for channelization, illumination, pavement markings, pedestrian crossing, and landscape restoration.

The Contracting Agency will provide the signal Controller Cabinet and controller for this project. The contractor will be required to coordinate with the Contracting Agency for delivery to the project site, unloading of the cabinet, installation of the cabinet, and furnishing and installing all wiring connection to provide a complete and operational traffic signal system.

The estimated cost of this project, for all bid schedules including additives, if any, is in the range of \$375,000 to \$410,000.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid proposal, including sales tax. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory payment and performance bonds within the time stated in the Contract Documents, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Maple Valley.

The (Local Agency) in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined

at 49 CFR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

To be eligible for award of this contract, the bidder must fill out and submit, as part of its bid proposal, the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Utilization Certification relating to Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (CGE) Requirements. A DBE subcontracting goal of 8% has been established for this project. The DBE Utilization Certification is included in the proposal.

This Invitation to Bid may be canceled at the discretion of the City. If the invitation is canceled, notice of cancellation will be sent to all parties who have registered on the Plan-holders list at Builders Exchange. The notice will briefly state the reason for cancellation.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality in the bidding, and to make the award to the lowest responsible bidder as determined by the City.
