

# CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. O-14-560

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING MAPLE VALLEY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.25.010, PAYMENT OF CLAIMS OR OBLIGATIONS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR CORRECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Maple Valley Municipal Code (MVMC) Section 3.25.010, Payment of claims or obligations of the City, in 1997; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution R-13-939 on August 5, 2013, designating a new financial institution the official bank for the City of Maple Valley;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Maple Valley Municipal Code, Section 3.25.010, Payment of claims or obligations of the City, is amended as follows (new text shown in underline, and deleted text shown in ~~strikethrough~~).

#### **3.25.010 Payment of claims or obligations of the City**

Pursuant to RCW 35A.40.020, payment of claims or obligations of the City shall be by check or warrant as is determined from time to time by the City Manager to be the most advantageous for the City. The qualified public depository, whereon such checks or warrants are to be drawn, shall be US Bank, Fred Meyer Office ~~Seattle First National Bank, Wilderness Village Branch~~ in Maple Valley, Washington. The City officers authorized to sign checks or warrants shall be the Mayor, the Chair of the Audit Committee, and the City Manager or his or her designee. Checks or warrants shall be signed by any two of the foregoing authorized signatories. The Mayor may appoint a designee to sign on his or her behalf, if both the Mayor and Chair of the Audit Committee will be unable to sign due to absence from the City or incapacity.

Section 2. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. Effective Date. A summary of this Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.

Section 4. Corrections by City Clerk or Code Reviser. Upon approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the code reviser are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance, including the correction of clerical errors; references to other local, state or federal laws, codes, rules, or regulations; or ordinance numbering and section/subsection numbering.
