RESOLUTION NO. R-00-127

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT WITH COVINGTON WATER DISTRICT TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN, OPERATE, REPLACE AND REPAIR A WATER SYSTEM IN, ACROSS, OVER, ALONG, UNDER, THROUGH AND BELOW CERTAIN DESIGNATED PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY

WHEREAS, the Covington Water District has requested that the City Council of the City of Maple Valley grant to the District a nonexclusive franchise; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35A.47.040 the City Council is authorized to grant franchises for the use of its streets, roads and other public properties; and

WHEREAS, in October, 1997 the City of Maple Valley and the Covington Water District entered into an Interlocal Agreement until such time as the City and the District formalized a franchise for water service within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the franchise granted herein is intended to replace and supercede the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Maple Valley and the Covington Water District for certain services, hookups, and repairs to the Covington Water District water systems infrastructure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE VALLEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City a Franchise with Covington Water District to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair a water system in, across, over, along, under, through and below certain designated public rights-of-way of the City of Maple Valley. A copy of the franchise agreement has been filed with the City Clerk and identified with Clerk's Receiving No. 166.
